

In The Bay Race - Saturday, June 4, 2005 - Additional Sailing Instructions

Revised 4/29/2005

CLASSES

There will be singlehanded and doublehanded divisions in this race. Each skipper must indicate on the entry form the division and class in which he or she is sailing.

SKIPPER'S MEETING

There will be a skipper's meeting on Wednesday, June 1, at 7:30 pm at the Oakland YC.

TROPHY PRESENTATION

There will be a trophy presentation on Wednesday, June 15, at 7:30 pm at the Oakland YC.

STARTING TIMES AND SIGNALS

The first Warning signal will be at 11:00 am. Thereafter, classes will start at 5-minute intervals.

START

The starting line is between the orange marker on the Corinthian Yacht Club race deck and the orange inflatable race mark immediately off the Corinthian Yacht Club, leaving the inflatable to port.

COURSE

From the Start,

to YRA 15 (yellow buoy "Y" approx. 0.5 nm E of Yellow Bluff) leaving it to port, then to YRA SC (GR "SC" FI G (2+1) approx. 1 nm ENE of Mission Rock Terminal) leaving it to port, then to Southampton Shoal (Iso R 6s 32ft 6M Bell) leaving it to port, then to the Finish.

Course distance 17.4 NM.

FINISH

The finish line is the same as the starting line, leaving the inflatable mark to port.

CHECK IN

Check-in via VHF radio channel 69 prior to the initial Warning signal for the race is mandatory.

REPORTING RETIREMENT

Any boat that retires from the race for any reason or does not finish within the time limit **must** contact the Race Committee as soon as possible via **VHF radio channel 69** or by leaving a message at the telephone number below.

TIME LIMIT

The time limit is 7:00 pm on the day of the race.
