

Half Moon Bay Race Saturday, August 23, 2008 Additional Sailing Instructions VHF Channel 69

CLASSES

There will be singlehanded and doublehanded divisions in this race. Each skipper must indicate on the entry form the division and class in which he or she is sailing.

SKIPPERS' MEETING

There will be a skippers' meeting on Wednesday, August 20, at 7:30 pm at Oakland Yacht Club.

TROPHY PRESENTATION

There will be a trophy presentation following the race at or near Half Moon Bay Yacht Club. Boats are encouraged to anchor or moor in the outer harbor near the yacht club, or to berth in the inner harbor. Fees for mooring or berthing are payable at the Pillar Point Harbormaster's office; there is no charge for anchoring.

DINNER

Dinner will be served at or near Half Moon Bay YC following the race for approx. \$25 per person. Please indicate on the race entry form the number of dinners for your party and enclose a check (payable to SSS) in the amount of \$25 per dinner.

STARTING TIMES AND SIGNALS

The first Warning signal will be at 9:30 am. Thereafter, classes will start at 5-minute intervals.

STARTING LINE

A line between the orange marker on the Golden Gate Yacht Club race deck and the "X" buoy off the Golden Gate Yacht Club, leaving "X" to starboard.

COURSE

From the Start to the Finish, leaving Colorado Reef buoy if (R "26" FI R 2.5s) and buoy G "1" FI G 2.5s GONG (approximately 1/2 mile SSW of Pillar Point) to port.

FINISH

The finish is at buoy G "3" FI G 4s BELL (approximately 3/4 mile S of the Pillar Point Harbor entrance), when the buoy bears 000° magnetic. There will be no committee boat on station. Skippers shall take their own finish time and deliver it in writing (on the HMB Finish Sheet, attached) to the Race Committee at HMBYC or the dinner site. **Skippers who do not submit their completed finish sheets by 7:45 pm will be scored DNF**. This modifies RRS A5.

CHECK-IN

Check-in via VHF radio channel 69 prior to the first Warning signal is mandatory.

REPORTING RETIREMENT

Any boat that retires from the race or does not finish within the time limit **must** contact the Race Committee as soon as possible via **VHF radio channel 69** or by leaving a message at the telephone number below.
