AMENDMENT #1 TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Paragraph 5 is amended to read:

5 STARTING TIMES

5.1 The first warning signal will be made at 1155 hours. Thereafter, classes will start at 5-minute intervals.

Paragraph 8 is amended to read:

8 FINISH

8.1 The finish line is from an orange flag on the Corinthian Yacht Club race deck flagpole, extending to the Point Stuart buoy (R "4", Fl R 2.5s). The line shall be crossed leaving the race deck to Port.

8.2 The Race Committee will attempt to staff the finish line continuously from 1800 hours on **Thursday, June 20**, through 1800 hours on Tuesday, June 25th.

8.3 Each yacht shall hail the Race Committee on VHF **channel 72** when it is within radio range of Corinthian Yacht Club and is preparing to finish. The yacht shall announce its Boat Name and Sail Number to the Race Committee. This hail should be made no later than crossing under the Golden Gate Bridge.

8.4 Each skipper shall record his or her own finish time, based on the time display on the boat's GPS receiver. As soon as possible the skipper shall notify the Race Committee of his or her finish time by telephone to (866) SailSSS [866-724-5777].

8.5 If finishing between Dusk and Dawn, each skipper shall illuminate the yacht's mainsail so that its finish can be seen and recorded.
